OFF AIR (antenna) - Is the only way in most communities to receive all four of the OETA Channels.

CABLE - Some Cable Systems carry the OETA Main Channel and World but only COX carries all four at this time.

SATELLITE - Dish Network and DirecTV only carry the OETA Main Channel in the OKC and Tulsa DMA. The southern half of the state with the Lawton DMA, Ardmore DMA, and Fort Smith DMA, and the Shreveport DMA do not carry OETA but carry only a national PBS feed which is not the OETA Channel. In the southern half of the state, OETA is available OFF AIR and on Cable Systems but not satellite.
