# FCL Facilitator – \$800 per workshop cycle

#### **Duties:**

As the primary workshop leader, the Facilitator is responsible for planning, leading, and evaluating a full series of FCL sessions (typically 4 per theme). Duties include guiding families through the workshop flow (Eat, Explore, Learn, Share), modeling inquiry-based learning, supporting the use of technology and PBS KIDS media, and creating a welcoming environment for diverse families.

- Comfort with tablets and digital tools
- Ability to model inclusive, playful, and inquiry-rich facilitation strategies

#### FCL Support Facilitator – \$500 per workshop cycle

The Support Facilitator ensures smooth delivery of workshops by helping manage the environment, providing hands-on assistance at activity stations, supporting transitions, and offering family engagement throughout the sessions. This role is essential for promoting accessibility, collaboration, and learner success.
